Houstonia longifolia Gaertn.



Family:	Rubiaceae
Habitat:	Open woods, stream sides, fields
Color:	Blue- whitish
Height:	5-10 in
Exposure:	Partial sun
Bloom Dates:	Apr-June
Soil Moisture:	Dry, well-drained
Soil Quality:	Average
Garden Uses:	Naturalizing in paths and meadows. Can be used in rock gardens.
Notes:	Easily crowded out if planted near too much competition. Flowers are light blue with a yellow center. May have a second bloom in summer.
