Aruncus dioicus (Walter) Fernald



Family:	Rosaceae
Habitat:	Rich woods; common sight along mountain roads in Appalachians
Color:	White
Height:	3-7 ft
Exposure:	Shade
Bloom Dates:	June-July
Soil Moisture:	Moist
Soil Quality:	Rich
Garden Uses:	Backdrop of shade/partial sun gardens; slopes.
Notes:	Source of nectar and pollen for bees, beetles, and flower flies, many of which prey on other pests. Flower plumes provide soft atmospheric effect.
