Lilium canadense L.



Family:	Liliaceae
Habitat:	Meadows; low thickets; wet woods
Color:	Orange, Red
Height:	2-5 ft
Exposure:	Sun, part sun
Bloom Dates:	June-July
Soil Moisture:	Moist
Soil Quality:	Rich
Garden Uses:	Borders, meadows. Tall, showy plant for perennial garden.
Notes:	Scatter through a moist garden or mixed border. Voles are attracted to them as is the Asian Lily Leaf Beetle. Nectar source for hummingbirds.
