Habitat:	Dry prairies; disturbed areas; sandy, open woods; thickets; roadsides
Color:	White – pink
Height:	5 ft.
Exposure:	Sun to shade
Bloom Dates:	June
Soil Moisture:	Average
Soil Quality:	Average
Garden Uses:	Ground cover, borders
Notes:	Drought tolerant. Very fragrant. Rocky, sandy soil. Best in open sunny locations. Susceptible to fungal problems. Width: 3-6 ft.
