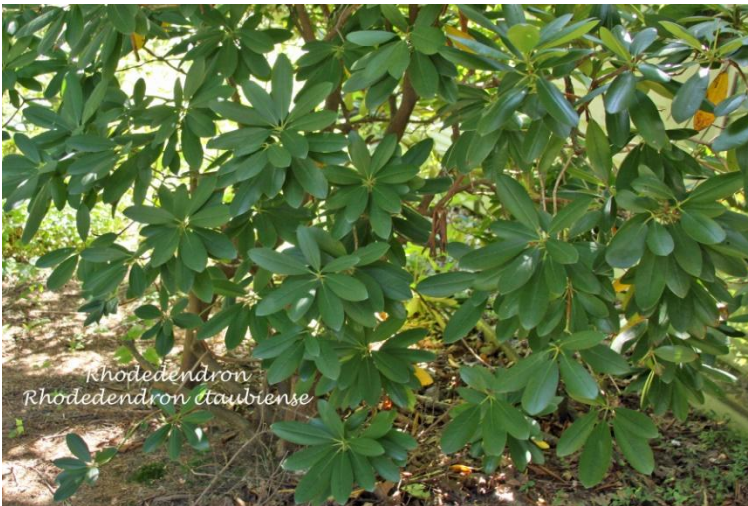


Catawba Rosebay

Notes:	Hummingbirds attracted to blooms.
