<b>Family:</b>	Osmundaceae
<b>Habitat:</b>	Moist rich soil - woods; Coastal swamps and moist mountains; slopes of eastern US.
<b>Color:</b>	Fertile stalk has cinnamon color
<b>Height:</b>	30-60 in
<b>Exposure:</b>	Shade to part sun
<b>Bloom Dates:</b>	
<b>Soil Moisture:</b>	Moist to wet
<b>Soil Quality:</b>	Rich
<b>Garden Uses:</b>	Strong focal point in large bed or garden. Best in moist, acidic soil. Width - 2-4 ft.
<b>Notes:</b>	Best in moist, acidic soil. Stately and versatile.
