

Marginal Wood Fern

Dryopteris marginalis (L.) A. Gray



Family:	Dryopteridaceae
Habitat:	Rocky slopes, cool shady woodlands. Likes rich, moist, well-drained soil but will tolerate a bit drier conditions.
Color:	N/A
Height:	18 -24 in
Exposure:	Shade to partial sun
Bloom Dates:	
Soil Moisture:	Moist, to well-drained
Soil Quality:	Rich
Garden Uses:	Shade garden; rock gardens, woodland landscape. Best in moist, acidic soil.
Notes:	Fern has glossy, evergreen fronds which form a circular cluster. Can tolerate periods of drought.
