

## Red Chokeberry

*Aronia arbutifolia* (L.) Ell.



<b>Family:</b>	Rosaceae
<b>Habitat:</b>	Bottomlands, bogs, swamps
<b>Color:</b>	White
<b>Height:</b>	6-12 ft.
<b>Exposure:</b>	Sun
<b>Bloom Dates:</b>	May
<b>Soil Moisture:</b>	Moist
<b>Soil Quality:</b>	Rich
<b>Garden Uses:</b>	Fragrant flowers and colorful autumn foliage
<b>Notes:</b>	Spreads by suckering. Needs space, but can be kept in check. A nice native alternative to burning bush.
