Polygonatum biflorum (Walter) Elliott



Family:	Liliaceae
Habitat:	Woods and thickets
Color:	White
Height:	1-3 ft
Exposure:	Shade
Bloom Dates:	May-June
Soil Moisture:	Moist
Soil Quality:	Rich
Garden Uses:	Individual or massed in shade or woodland gardens.
Notes:	White bell-shaped flowers which turn into blue berries. Divide every 5 years or so.
