Oenothera fruticosa L. ssp. *fruticosa*



Family:	Onagraceae
Habitat:	Meadows, dry, open woods, roadsides.
Color:	Yellow
Height:	1-2 ft
Exposure:	Sun, part sun
Bloom Dates:	May-July
Soil Moisture:	Average
Soil Quality:	Average
Garden Uses:	Borders, rock gardens, naturalizing.
Notes:	Good with, butterfly weed, gray beard tongue. Somewhat drought tolerant; blooms open in morning and last a few days. Excessively fertile soil encourages aggressive spreading.
