

Turk's Cap Lily

Lilium superbum L.



Family:	Liliaceae
Habitat:	Wet meadows, swampy woods, mountain coves
Color:	Orange
Height:	3-8 ft
Exposure:	Sun, part sun
Bloom Dates:	July-Aug
Soil Moisture:	Moist
Soil Quality:	Rich, deep
Garden Uses:	Borders, meadows, Mixed near back of sunny garden, effective with evergreens. Woodland borders
Notes:	A spectacular lily in bloom and easy to grow. Can be grown in containers if watered regularly. Protect from wind. Nectar source for hummingbirds and orioles. Deer will eat.
