Habitat:	Rich, wooded slopes and rocky places
Color:	Pink
Height:	1.5-2 ft
Exposure:	Partial sun
Bloom Dates:	Apr-Sept
Soil Moisture:	Moist
Soil Quality:	Rich
Garden Uses:	Shade garden; rock gardens, woodland landscape. .
Notes:	Forms dense, leafy clumps. Blooms over long season in spring and summer. Best in moist, acidic soil.
