

Wild Geranium

Geranium maculatum L.



Family: Geraniaceae

Habitat: Open woods and clearings; roadsides

Color: Pink

Height: 14-18 in

Exposure: Sun to light shade

Bloom Dates: Apr-June
Soil Moisture: Average
Soil Quality: Rich

Garden Uses: Front or middle of shade to partially sunny gardens;

naturalizing.

Notes: Great companions to maidenhair fern or wild
