

Wild Geranium

Geranium maculatum L.



Family:	Geraniaceae
Habitat:	Open woods and clearings; roadsides
Color:	Pink
Height:	14-18 in
Exposure:	Sun to light shade
Bloom Dates:	Apr-June
Soil Moisture:	Average
Soil Quality:	Rich
Garden Uses:	Front or middle of shade to partially sunny gardens; naturalizing.
Notes:	Great companions to maidenhair fern or wild bleeding heart. Spreads readily. Goes semi-dormant after seed is shed. Will do best if soil, at least in spring, is fairly moist.
